B.Sc. Nursing

B.Sc. Nursing: Semester

The duration of B.Sc. Nursing program is 8 Semester. English is the medium of instruction of course for all subjects of study and examination. Course will commence from first week of July every year.

ELIGIBILITY:

10+2 with 45% integrated marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English (PCBE) 5% relaxation for SC/ST. Age – 17 years by 31 December 2023. Selection of candidates should be based on the merit of the entrance examination.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

Higher secondary school certificate (10 + 2) 12th standard from recognized Board with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB) with minimum of 45% aggregate marks in PCB. English must be a compulsory subject. SC/ST candidates will be given 5 % of relaxation in aggregate marks in PCB.

AGE/PHYSICAL STANDARD

The age of the candidate should be 17 years or should complete 17 years before 31st December of the admission year. Candidate should be physically and mentally healthy.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION FORM

The candidate will be selected on the basis of merit of marks obtained in 12th standard and entrance exam. Admission will be provisional till university provides eligibility. Student will get 15 days winter and 30 days summer vacation. No other leave is permissible.

Documents required at the time of admission:

- 1. Certificate of passing the qualifying examination.
- 2. Original mark sheet of H.S.C.
- 3. Original mark sheet of S.S.C./S.S.L.C.
- 4. Transfer Certificate or School Leaving Certificate, Migration certificate original.
- 5. Caste certificate issued by the competent authority, if admission is against reserved category.
- 6. Character/Conduct Certificate.
- 7. Aadhar Card, Voter ID.
- 8. Certificate of change of name, if applicable supported by documentary evidence like government Gazette.
- 9. Gap certificate.

Post Basic Nursing

Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing (PB-B.Sc.) is a two-year undergrad program intended to instill an inside and out comprehension of Advanced level Nursing Knowledge. This enables students to transit their learning in practical by providing complete Medicare Facilities to patients. The students acquire both surgical and non-surgical nursing skills that prepare them for varied real-world clinical and hospital settings.

The programmer prepares students to take independent decisions in nursing situations and play a major role in treating patients with care and compassion. The programmer curriculum comprises subjects like Maternal Nursing, Medical & Surgical Nursing, Microbiology and Mental Health Nursing.

ELIGIBILITY

Passed GNM after completing 10+2 Candidate should also be a registered Nurse and Midwife.

GNM

General Nursing and Midwifery or GNM is 3 Years a diploma programmer designed for aspirants who want to pursue a career in clinical nursing. The programmer teaches candidates how to care for individuals who are sick or have been injured in order to help them attain full recovery. Although the curriculum design of the course varies from university to university, GNM courses are designed to prepare the students for clinical approach of handling patients. The curriculum of some universities includes a six-month internship at the end of the course and the diploma is granted only after the candidates complete this internship.

RULES AND REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED IN THE COLLEGE.

College of Nursing prepares its graduates to become exemplary citizens by adhering to code of ethics and professional conduct at all times in fulfilling personal and professional obligations.

- Every student admitted to the Basic B.Sc. Nursing course shall have to follow rules and Regulations of the Nursing College.
- 2. Students are responsible to the Principal for their behavior, both in and outside the Campus.
- 3. All decisions taken by the management are final.
- 4. Students must assemble in the college campus for the prayer sharp at 8.45 am every day.
- 5. Students are required to be regular and punctual for the class. Students are expected to be In the class at least 5 minutes before the commencement of the period.
- 6. Students should maintain perfect order and strict silence inside the lecture hall.
- 7. Movement outside the class room in between lectures should be minimum and for valid Reasons only.
- 8. Students will not be allowed to use mobile phones inside the class rooms.
- 9. Loitering around the corridors during classes and attending other classes are not allowed.
- 10. Students should maintain silence in the class, library, reading room and in the corridors.

Students should make every effort to take care of the college and hospital property and help in maintaining the same. They should not write on the black board, scribble on tables, Chairs, walls etc.

- 1. Students are not allowed to come directly to the Principal office without permission of the class coordinator, until there is any emergency.
- 2. If the students have any problem, they should inform the class representative and the class representative will intimate it to the class coordinators. If the problem is not solved at the class coordinator's level, then the class students should by-pass the above mentioned channels. Exceptions are allowed only if the problem is outmost urgent/serious.
- 11. Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards in behavior both inside and outside the college.
- 12. Each student is responsible for the proper handling and safe custody of any apparatus or equipment that she may be using in different nursing labs. Misuse or negligence will result in replacement of the particular item by the candidate. Any willful damage done to the property of the college or hospital will be treated as breach of discipline.
- 13. Students are not allowed to paste notices within the institutions without prior written permission from the Office of the Principal.
- 14. Students are forbidden to communicate with any person outside the authority without permission from the Office of the Principal.
- 15. Any student who damages the reputation of the college in any way is liable to be expelled. If any student discontinues the course, she shall clear all dues before leaving the college. If she fails to pay, her original certificates will be retained and will be returned once the dues are cleared by the student.
- 16. Violating the rules of college will be dealt with seriously by the college authorities and if necessary dismissal from the college may be considered depending upon the seriousness of the violation.
- 17. The college provides transport facilities for students field work but whenever this is not feasible, the student will have to use public transport at her own expenses.

ANTI RAGGING RULES

Antiragging Cell

Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in the entire institution, within the campus or outside and as per the provisions of the Act of the Central Government and the State Government, strict action shall be taken against those found guilty of ragging and / or of abetting ragging

Ragging is a cognizable offence under the law and prohibited in all its forms for ensuring this we have the anti ragging cell in the institution.

Anti Ragging Rules

The following is a description of what constitutes ragging as per the Raghavan Committee recommendation to the Supreme Court: Ragging is as any act which violates the dignity of the individual student or is perceived to violate his/her dignity. Ragging is a cognizable, non-bailable, non-compoundable offence with punishment ranging from one year imprisonment and fine up to 7 years rigorous imprisonment and fine.

Broadly ragging can be categorized in the following way for which various term of punishment are prescribed

Verbal: Where senior causes mental harassment, discomfort for the junior by forcing him/her to answer unacceptable/ personal questions, dance, sing etc is said to rag the junior. It also includes within its ambit cyber ragging. Punishment: 1 year imprisonment or fine or both.

Severe Verbal Ragging: Where the mental harassment, discomfort is to such an act as forces the junior to withdraw from the college. Punishment: 7 year imprisonment with fine.

Physical: Any act by the senior towards the junior which in icts bodily injury on the junior, like beating the junior, hitting him/her with objects etc. Punishment: 7 year imprisonment with fine.

Sexual Ragging: Where the senior asks the junior to do an act which damages sexual dignity of the junior. Punishment: 7 year rigorous imprisonment and fine. Penalty For Ragging (Institute Level)

Expulsion from the educational institution, if found guilty on inquiry by the Institution against a complaint lodged by any other student.

Any student convicted with imprisonment shall be dismissed from the educational institution in which he/she has been prosecuting his studies for the time being and shall not be readmitted to that educational institution.


